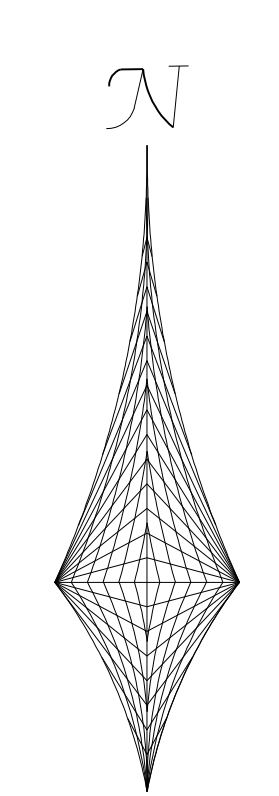

No attempt has been made to show all drainage canals and ditches.

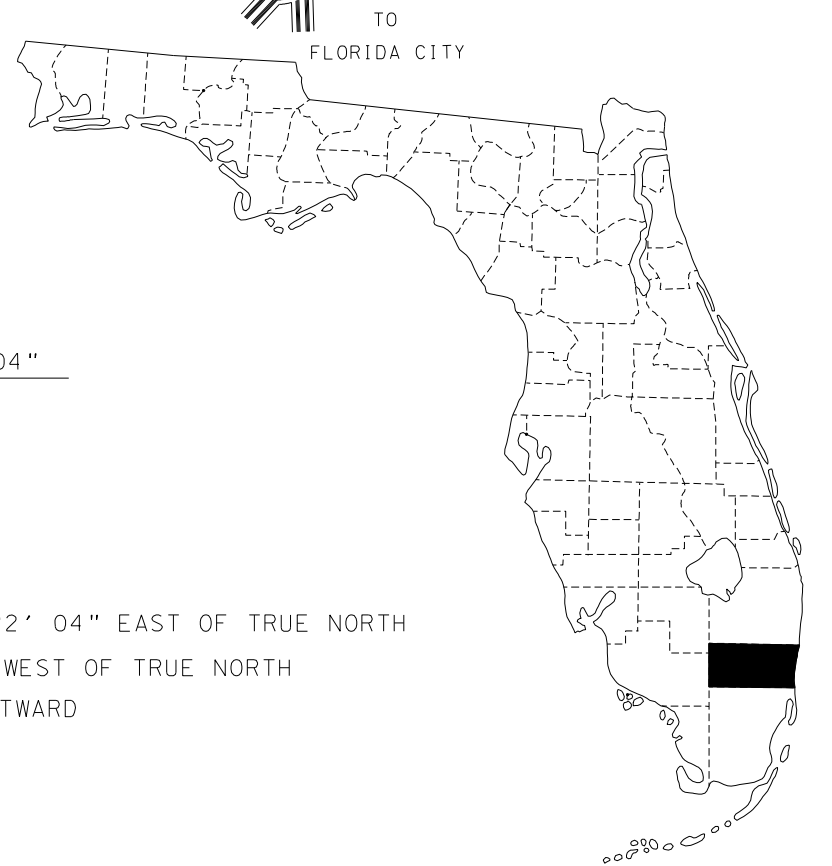
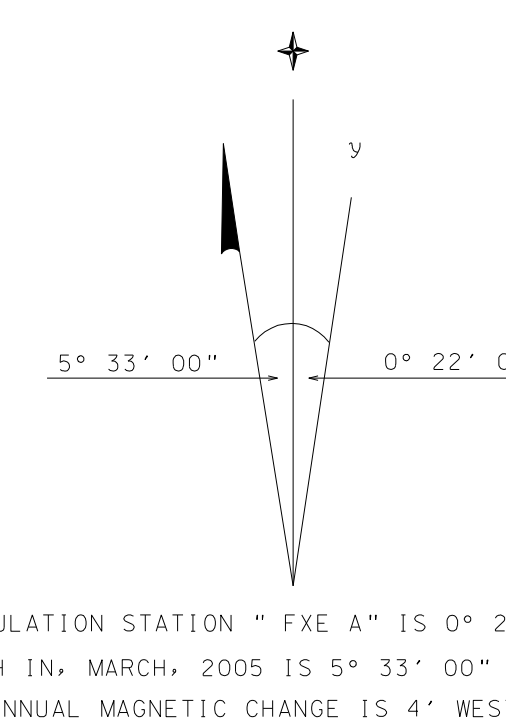
City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 2000.
